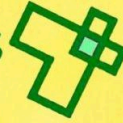

1 John 4:18

“You are the light of the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden... let your light shine before others.”

Matthew 5:14-16

Like a spring brings forth water, we project what's inside. If Christ is in you, light is in you and light doesn't lie low.

Jesus says “I am the way, the truth, and the life” (John 14:6); He also says “I am the light of the world” (John 8:12). When we receive Him, we receive the Spirit of Christ. Apostle Paul also said "you are light in the Lord" (Ephesians 5:8). Not becoming light someday, you are right now.

Practically, your actions carry more weight than your words: neighbours note honesty; colleagues feel steadiness; homes show patience. Character carries it even when mouths are closed. And where light spreads, darkness folds, in habits, in atmospheres, in small daily choices.

You are the light of the world, not by effort but by God's Spirit indwelling you. Don't hide it. Let your environment feel what lives on your inside.

Paul writes to Timothy about foods, but the principle is bigger: everything God created is good, and it's meant to be received with thanksgiving. Thanksgiving here isn't just saying grace, it's employing what He gave.

We see this with spiritual gifts. People ask, “Do I need tongues? God hears me when I pray in understanding so why stress?” Fair question. But think about it: God gave the Spirit and capacity included with our needs in mind, before we were even conceived. To set it aside as unnecessary looks logical to us, yet it quietly treats His provision as excess. That's waste. And waste leans toward ingratitude.

God loves the ungrateful man; He doesn't love ungratefulness. He loves the waster; He doesn't love waste. When gifts sit unused, we rob ourselves of it's fullness and we miss saying “thank you” in the clearest way: by the use.

So today's question is how much of God's Spirit are you putting to work? How much of His grace is in expression through you? Your productiveness and your gratefulness, is measured by the use.
