SAY IT AS IT IS

“And he took him by the right hand, and lifted him up: and immediately his feet and ankle bones received strength.”

Acts 3:7

You should relate to this: you hear a testimony, but instead of increasing in faith, you feel depleted. This is often because those testimonies are sugar-coated.

Exaggerating our experience of God's power in order to make it mystical not only takes away the originality of the miracle, but it rids the hearers of the opportunity to replicate such miracles.

As we see in the referenced text, Apostle Peter took the lame man by the hand and lifted him up. The bible did not say the man jumped up after he heard the word. The description was clear.

In the same vein, our description of the miraculous ought to be accurate. Don't say you experienced a miracle overnight when you walked in faith for months before getting it.

Don't say you got the contract mysteriously by grace when in fact you put out an application and then you were selected.

Likewise, don't say you worked so hard to be promoted when you got the promotion by favour.

Don't deny others the opportunity to replicate a miracle you enjoyed. Do not exaggerate. Be sincere in your description of the miraculous.

Scripture is clear and direct that patience is not optional for the believer but necessary. The believer does not only need faith, prayer, obedience, or thanksgiving. The believer also needs patience.

Notice what the scripture does not say. It does not say God will give the promise after patience. It says we receive the promise after patience. This tells us that the giving and the receiving are not always at the same time. Between God’s giving and our receiving, patience must do its work.

Many people assume delay means denial but this is a mistake. God is not slow. God is faithful. The delay often exists because of processes and systems in the earth. These do not cancel God’s promise, but they require patience from the believer.

Beloved, do not interpret time as God’s absence. Do not mistake delay for failure. You “have need of patience” so that you may receive what God has already promised.
