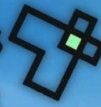

It means you can put together every oil field, skyscraper, bank vault, or empire that has ever existed on this earth, and they will still not be enough to buy back one single human soul. That is how valuable you are.

This is why God did not send gold to redeem you. He did not send silver or any earthly currency. He sent His own Son. He paid with the most expensive thing in all of eternity, the precious blood of Jesus. No man, no devil, no amount of sin can diminish what that blood has already purchased.

People sometimes say they have sold their soul to the devil in exchange for fame or success. But the truth is that moment a person genuinely receives Jesus, the blood of Christ goes to the deepest place and brings that soul back. There is nothing beyond the reach of that sacrifice.
